## Caverion secures a Managed Services agreement with Sollentuna municipality in Sweden

Caverion has secured a new Managed Services agreement with the Swedish municipality of Sollentuna in Stockholm County. Caverion will be responsible for Managed Operations, including Technical Maintenance of around 70 public buildings in Sollentuna, including schools, day care centres, sports centres and also a number of listed buildings such as Edberg's castle.

The value of the 4-year agreement, starting October 1, 2016, is around EUR 6 million. The agreement further includes an option for up to four years. The total floor area of the buildings is estimated at 170,000 m2.

We are naturally pleased to be entrusted with making sure that the municipality's schools provide a good indoor environment for its students and to be given the opportunity to develop the life cycle of a large number of public buildings," says Thomas Lundin, Executive Vice President & CEO, Division Sweden of Caverion.

The agreement includes targets to lower the running costs and to increase the energy efficiency. The following disciplines are covered by the contract: Heating and Sanitation, Ventilation & Air Conditioning, Cooling, Electricity and Security & Safety.
